SUMMER PROGRESS REPORT: YEAR 10

The enclosed full report gives you an indication of your child’s current attainment and attitude to learning within each subject. Each child’s **attendance** for the year to date is given at the bottom of the report. We encourage high levels of attendance as this is a crucial factor in academic success at school.

The majority of GCSE grades are displayed as 9 (high) to 1 (low), as this is how those subjects will be graded in summer 2018. Business, Media, Sociology and DT subjects are still graded as the familiar A*-G. *A rough guide of grade equivalences is displayed here for your information.*

The **Current Grade** is a teacher assessment of the grade that your child is currently working at, taking into account exam performance, controlled assessments, coursework, etc.

The **Most Likely Grade** is a professional prediction by the teacher, of your child’s most likely grade at the end of Year 11. This is reliant on your child continuing to progress as they are at the moment. The grades are colour coded to give an indication of how the grade compares to an aspirational target for each student. The targets are based upon your child’s Key Stage 2 tests, to ensure that over their 5 years of secondary schooling, they make strong progress.
