Year 7 Settling-In Report

I hope that you and your child have felt warmly-welcomed at Newquay Tretherras. We were delighted that so many of you were able to attend the recent Expectations Evening, which I hope you all felt was valuable.

The enclosed report gives you an early indication of your child's attitude to learning within each subject as well as an early grade for their ability in English and Maths.

Attitude to Learning is a crucial element of learning and you will see how teachers have judged your child's **Behaviour**, **Engagement** and **Organisation**, as far as their approach to study goes. This is judged as either *Excellent*, *Good*, *Requires Improvement* or *Unsatisfactory* in each area.

A **current GCSE Grade** has been included for English and Maths. This is a teacher assessment of what grade your child is currently working at. This will increase in time, as long as they have a good attitude to learning and high rates of attendance. The grade is highlighted to show whether your child is on track for an individualised aspirational target. For those not yet working at a GCSE grade 1, an "intermediate" scale, i1 (low) to i5 (high), is in place.

An indication of the current **Attendance Percentage** for your child is given at the bottom of the report. We encourage high levels of attendance as this is a crucial factor in academic success at school.
