Please find below the outline travel details of our forthcoming trip to France in July.

Travel Arrangements:

Outward Journey:

Sunday 8th July 2018

Depart from: Newquay Tretherras Senior Car Park
Meet time: **07.15 hrs.** To load coach
Depart Newquay: **07.30 hrs.**
Ferry Crossing: Dover – Calais at 16.40 hrs
Arrive: Calais 19.10 hrs (Local time)
Arrive at destination: 09.00 hrs Monday 11th July (Local time)

Return Journey:

Sunday 15th July 2016

Depart from: Domaine de Segries 19:00hrs (Local time)
Ferry crossing: 07.45 hrs (Local time)
Arrive: 08.15 hrs **Monday 16th July** (UK time)
Arrival time at NTS: Approx. 16.15hrs

All students will need a substantial packed lunch for the outward journey, but please no fizzy drinks, as well as a range of suitable items of entertainment.

If in the case of an emergency and you need to contact your son/daughter whilst they are away on the trip, please contact Richard Higginson in the first instance who will then contact me on your behalf. He can be contacted on 07711009942. I would also ask that you check that the contact numbers you have submitted on the yellow consent forms are correct. If you have subsequently planned an impromptu weekend away etc., please ensure that I have a contact number that he can reach you on at all times whilst we are away.

If you were unable to attend the meeting, please send your child to see me to get a kit list and/or discuss anything you are unsure of. You can find a copy of the presentation and the kit list on the school website, under letters and notices.

Essential items are:

Suntan Lotion (30+)

T Shirt that covers shoulders and can be worn in the water (rash vest is ideal)

Shoes to worn in the water.

Swimsuit

Each student is only allowed one main luggage bag and one small bag for use on the coach, in addition to their PILLOW and SLEEPING BAG. Please can all items be clearly labelled with your child's name. They will also need their toothbrush, toothpaste and any other items needed for an overnight journey packed in their small bag. I would like to remind you of the collective decisions made:

- Students are discouraged from bringing mobile phones, as we cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage. Phone cards can be purchased at both sites.
- Valuables need to be kept to a minimum – we recommend disposable cameras - no portable DVD players.
- DVDs for the coach journey need to be cert 12a or lower and I have the final say as to their suitability.
- Spending money needs to be in **Euros** with a small amount of sterling for the return trip. This must be handed in to **Mrs Pearce** in a sealed envelope with your son/daughter's name and amount clearly labelled.
- Each child needs a valid **passport** and **EHIC** card, which is to be handed in to **Mr Johnson** as we board the coach. (A photocopy of both should have already been handed in to Miss Bray prior to the trip)
- Any **medication** needs to be clearly labelled with your child's name on it, with instructions if required, and handed to **Mr Rapier** as we board the coach.
