YEAR 7 ACTIVITIES WEEK 2018

Dear Parent/Carer

I am now in a position to give the final arrangements for the Year 7 activities week.

Can I please ask you to pay any outstanding monies through Parent Pay by Friday 4^h June.

We will be camping at Nine Ashes Scout Camp, Pencarrow, nr Bodmin from Sunday 8th July to Friday 13th July. We have divided the year group up into 3 camps, each camp lasting for 2 full days and 1 night. The students from the same form will be attending the same camp, however some forms have had to be divided once on camp, in order to balance out the numbers when they are taking part in the activities.

Your child will be attending the **second camp**, which will be leaving school at 8.15am **(please arrive at 8am)** on Tuesday 10th July and returning to school on Wednesday 11th July at 5.30pm.

All students should meet ON THE JUNIOR TENNIS COURTS when they are going on camp, lining up in their form groups. Can I please ask you to arrange to pick your child up from the Senior Car Park at the above times at the end of their camp.

Please can you supply your child with a packed lunch for the first day on camp. They will need this in a separate bag to their main luggage, with a drink, as we will be starting the first activity as soon as possible on the first day of each camp.

On the **Newquay Zoo** day students are to register as a normal school day; in their form rooms, and to wear appropriate clothing for a day at the zoo. More details will be given to the students in an assembly nearer the time. They will need a packed lunch, a drink and a small amount of pocket money. Students will return to school for a 3pm dismissal as normal or if they walk home slightly earlier from the zoo.

The **Camel Creek Adventure Park Day** will begin with students registering as a normal school day; in their form rooms and in appropriate clothing for a day at the leisure park. They will need a packed lunch, a drink and a small amount of pocket money. Students will return to school for a 3pm dismissal as normal.

The **Beach Day** is based at Porth Beach but students are to register as normal in school and will be dismissed from school at 3:00pm. Students need to come to school in clothing appropriate for a day at the beach with consideration for the weather on the day. They will need a packed lunch, towel, swimming costume (if they intend to swim), sun cream, a hat and plenty of fluids.

MEDICINES AND MEDICAL PROBLEMS

Please label the medication with your child's name. All medicines except inhalers should be given to a member of staff on arrival at camp, these will then be placed in our first aid kit. If there are any changes to the provided medical details by the time of camp please inform us.
