Terminology...

Current Grade (English & Maths)— the teacher's judgement about where a student is working currently, taking into account all aspects of the students' work.

Step (All Other Subjects) – based on the age expectations for that subject. The Steps are as follows: **Emerging**, **Developing**, **Secure** & **Extending**.

Projected Grade – represents good progress from the student's KS2 test outcomes. This should **never** be seen as a ceiling.

Attitude to Learning – the student's thirst for learning and their behaviour & effort both in class and with their homework.






Class charts will show you how to view your child's positive and negative behaviour in and out of class:




Ambition


