

## 'Non Knitter' Poppy Pattern

4mm needles

Cast on 12sts, knit 28 rows.

Cast off.

Run a line of yarn from side to side 6 ridges down from the top and pull slightly to 'pinch' the sides.

Secure ends and sew button to finish.



## Easy Knitted Poppy Pattern

Cast on 7 stitches

\*Knit 20 rows garter st

Knit 4 rows stocking st starting with purl row\*

Repeat 4 times.

Cast off

Sew ends together

Use long thread to loop through one side, draw together tightly and secure.

Sew button in middle.



## British legion Poppy Pattern- Slightly Frilled poppy

Cast on 120 stitches.

Rows 1-4 Knit

Row 5 Knit 3 stiches together across the row (40 stiches)

Rows 6-9 Knit

Row 10 Knit 2 stitches together across the row (20 stitches)

Rows 11-14 Knit

Row 15 Knit 2 stitches together across the row (10 stitches)

Cut yarn leaving a tail of about 20cm. Thread tail through yarn needle and slip all the remaining live stitches onto the yarn tail and pull tight. Pull around into a circle and then stitch seam. Sew in ends.

Centre of Poppy Using B, cast on 16 sts. Cast off. Coil into a tight spiral and sew base to the centre or use a black button to centre of poppy.

### **Knitted Poppy Pattern**

4mm (UK8) knitting needles

Cast on 80 sts.

Row 1 to row 8 knit every row.

Row 9 Knit 2 together (k2tog), repeat to end (40sts)

Row 10 K2 tog to end (20sts)

Row 11 K2 tog to end (10sts)

Cut yarn with a long end and thread a sewing needle. Run yarn through remaining 10 sts . Remove them off the needle , pull up tight, sew up side seam and fasten off.

Sew a black button to centre



### **Easy ribbed poppy pattern**

Cast on 60 stitches

Row s1 -10 : K2, P2 across whole row(for a slightly smaller poppy do 8 rows of rib).

Row 11 : Knit 2 stitches together across the row (30 stitches).

Row 12 : Slip 1 stitch, Knit 2 stitches together then pass the slip stitch over... repeat across the whole row (10 stitches).

Break off yarn with long tail and thread back through remaining stitches and pull tight. Sew edges together

## Crochet Poppies

### Three petal crochet poppy

With 4.5mm hook Ch 3, join with slst to form circle.

Ch 3, work 9 dc into the centre of the circle and join with slst.

Work the three petals separately.

Petal 1. Ch 3, work 1st dc into same st, work 2 dc into each of the next 3 sts. ch 1 work 2 sc into each st, tie off.

Petal 2. work 2 dc into last dc of previous petal, work 2 dc into each of the next 3 sts. ch 1 work 2 sc into each st, tie off.

Work petal 3 as 2.

Sew all ends in and attach button in the centre.

### Two petal crochet poppy

Round 1:

With 3mm hook and wool, ch2. Make 10dc in 2nd ch from hook. Join with a slst in 1st dc. (10sts)

Round 2:

\*ch1 dc ch1 2tr in next st, 3tr in next st, 2tr ch1 dc in next st, slst in next 2sts. rep from \* once again.

Round 3:

\*ch1 3dc in next 2 sts, 2dc in next 5sts, 3dc in next 2 sts,slst in next 2sts. rep from \* once again.

Fasten off. Attach button in the centre.

**Stitch explanation** st(s) = stitch (es) ch = chain rep=repeat dc = double crochet rnd=round htr = half treble crochet slst = slip stitch r = row tr = treble crochet
