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GCSE Geography Revision Saturdays

Dear Parent/Carer,

All Geography students have been given a **revision folder** before Christmas. They should be using this along with their Exercise Books, Revision guide and other online resources to revise for their exams. Please see reverse for tips on how to revise for Geography.

In addition, prior to each exam, we will be running **2 Super Saturday revision sessions** for Papers 1 and 2 (optional) and **a compulsory skills preparation session** for Paper 3. The optional Saturday sessions will involve 3 x 1 hour workshops. Students are expected to arrive to the 6th form centre at 9am and they will rotate through the sessions where there will be emphasis on exam technique and applying the knowledge and understanding they have already revised to different types of questions, finishing at 1pm (we will not be cramming content revision). Students can wear non-uniform and refreshments will be provided.
