Day 1

Relax and enjoy your flight from London Heathrow to Keflavik, Reykjavik.

Meet your coach/guide upon arrival at Keflavik airport.

Coach transfer from the airport to your hotel in Hvolsvollur.

Drive through **Hveragerdi**, a town next to the mountains and in a valley of steaming hot springs.

Visit the **LAVA Centre** with interactive experiences.

Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Overnight in Hvolsvollur area for the next 3 nights, in superior log cabins, hotel or guest house accommodation. All meals will be provided including breakfast, packed lunches and dinners.



Day 2

Seljalandfoss Waterfall – view this magnificent wall of water by walking behind it to feel its power.

Skogar Folk Museum – learn about the heritage of the Icelandic community.

Skogafoss Waterfall – visit one of Iceland's most beautiful waterfalls.

Solheimajokull Glacier – view this magnificent glacier with its crevices, ice ridges and sink holes.

Vik – the rainiest spot in Iceland with black sand beaches, rocky cliffs and stunning headland.

Reynisdrangar - view the pillars and basalt rock stacks which rise from the sea.

Dyrholaey – meaning 'the door hole island' which is a 120m archway.

Second night in Hvolsvollur area for tonight.

Day 3

Gullfoss – one of Iceland's impressive waterfalls and part of the Golden Circle.

Strokkur – A Geyser that erupts every 3 to 8 minutes spraying water 35 metres in the air.

Great Geysir – the Geyser from which all the worlds spouting hot springs were named. No longer as active as it once was, it can throw boiling water 5 to 10 meters high up to 3 times a day.

Thingvellir National Park – Iceland's first national park with the country's largest lake. This rift valley was the site of Iceland's Parliament from 930 to 1789.

You will arrive in Reykjavik this evening.

Enjoy dinner at the hotel.

Overnight in a Reykjavik Hotel, such as Hlemmur Square. All meals will be provided including breakfast, packed lunches and dinners.



Day 5

Coach transfer from your hotel to the airport to your airport, no guide today.

Subject to confirmed flight times, you can spend the morning shopping in Reykjavik.

Day 4

Blue Lagoon – enjoy the bright blue mineral waters of the Blue Lagoon with its Geothermally heated water in the middle of a Lava field.

Reykjanes Peninsula – Visit this Peninsula before you flight where is contains lava cones and craters, and is a hot bed of geothermal activity.

Perlan Viewing Platform – enjoy great views of Reykjavik from this building with its glass dome.

Reykjavik – the capital of Iceland and slightly south of the Arctic Circle. Take a walking tour of the city with its beautiful coastline and colourful centre.

Overnight in a Reykjavik Hotel, such as Hlemmur Square. All meals will be provided including breakfast, packed lunches and dinners.
