

A Parent / Carer Guide to Distance Learning

How will teachers set work and how can we help?

- ✓ Teachers will set work on ClassCharts using the below timetable (PE and SMSC will set an optional 'Healthy Body' and 'Healthy Mind' activity every day on their Facebook pages for all year groups)
- ✓ All timetabled work below should be completed by the deadline given by the teacher
- ✓ Teachers will acknowledge completion and then feedback if appropriate
- ✓ Teachers will not set extra homework, nor school work for weekends / holidays
- ✓ As a minimum expectation (we know you can do more than this!) they should be working for:
 Years 7 & 8: **1- 2 hours a working school day**
 Years 9, 10 and 11: **2-3 hours a working school day**
 Years 12 and 13: **3-5 hours a working school day**
- ✓ Help them structure their day, have a place to work, and work without social media distractions
- ✓ Are they stuck? Use any school books they have at home, own research, or call friends to help
- ✓ Praise and celebrate their work, their resilience and their knowledge!

How will teachers feedback work?

- ✓ Your child needs to upload the work as the teacher has asked
- ✓ Not all work will need to be uploaded and, just like in the classroom, not all work will be marked
- ✓ Marked work could be given back as whole class feedback where the teacher reflects on next steps suitable to all; or individually using the 'Leave Feedback' function on ClassCharts
