### Some suggestions of things to do ...

#### The Taylors have been busy again!

**IF** you are able to get hold of some flour and you don't need it to cook with then this looks great fun!

#### <u>Recipe</u>

- 500g Plain Flour
- 250g Salt
- 250ml of water

Preheat oven on 100 degrees. Mix Salt & flour together in a large mixing bowl. Gradually add the water, mixing in the flour & salt. Kneed into a ball. Roll out using a rolling pin on a lightly floured surface. Gently transfer on to a baking sheet with baking paper on (if available)

Create your own design by pressing hands into dough. If you intend to hang on a wall, put 2 holes in. Once your design is finished, transfer to oven. Bake at 100 degrees for 3 - 4 hours or until hard.

Remove from oven, allow to cool before painting. We used a white acrylic paint for our base & other coloured acrylic paints for details. If available you can seal by spraying with a spray sealant. Use ribbon or string to hang once dried.
