

NT Uniform Protocols 2021 -Guidance for Parents

- We are very proud of the uniform worn by our students and recognise the part it plays in instilling a sense of community and expectations of good behaviour. Our high standards are just one reason why Tretherras remains a popular and heavily over-subscribed school.
- If you ever need any support with Uniform, please contact your son or daughter's Form Tutor or a Well-being mentor in the first instance.
- Please be aware that if you receive 2 uniform notifications via classcharts in a week, or there are significant uniform issues then you will be contacted, and your son/daughter may be withdrawn from circulation and/or given a detention.

Issue	School Response	Follow Up/ Contact
No Blazer	We will record this and contact you. If possible, we will provide a spare for the day. For multiple offences students may be taken out of circulation at break/lunchtime or be issued a detention.	Classcharts notification
No Tie	We will record and contact you. If possible, we will provide a spare. For multiple offences students may be taken out of circulation at break/lunchtime or be issued a detention.	Classcharts notification
Tube Skirt/ very short skirt	The Form Tutor will contact home to arrange a time frame for replacement.	You will be contacted by the Form Tutor.
White Socks	HOYs will provide black socks.	You will be contacted if it becomes a persistent issue.
Over the knee socks	The Form Tutor will contact you and ask you to replace with knee length socks.	You will be contacted if it becomes a persistent issue.
Incorrect Tights (including ripped)	The HOY/ Form Tutor can provide replacement tights.	You will be contacted if it becomes a persistent issue.
Incorrect Shoes	The Form Tutor will record and phone to discuss with you.	Form Tutor will contact home.
Jumper/hoodie	The Jumper/Hoodie must be removed when inside. It may be confiscated if the issue is ongoing or escalates.	Form Tutor will contact home.
Coat	Students are encouraged to have a coat for school and any other clothing worn over the blazer for warmth must be removed prior to entering the building and placed in their school bag or locker.	Classcharts notification
Nose Stud	They must be removed in form time and placed in a named envelope. This will be sent to the Main/Quay office and can be collected at the end of day.	Classcharts notification
Hooped earrings	Removed in form and placed in named envelope-sent to Main or Quay office- collected at end of day.	-
Necklaces	Removed in form and placed in named envelope-sent to Main/Quay office- collected at end of day.	-
Painted nails	Nail varnish remover will be provided.	-
Acrylic Nails	Students may not be allowed to participate in any practical work. If a persistent issue, students may be taken out of circulation at break/lunchtime or issued detentions until removed.	Classcharts notification and/or call from form tutor.
Excessive Make up	All Heads of Years have hypoallergenic make-up remover.	You will only be contacted for persistent issues.
Incorrect hair colour /weave	We will contact you to arrange a time frame to rectify. In the meantime, a student may be internally excluded in the withdrawal room.	Form tutor will contact home.
Shaved Head / skinhead Tracks etc.	We will contact you to discuss. In the meantime, a student may be internally excluded in the withdrawal room.	Form Tutor will contact home.
