CONTRACT and POLICY for INSTRUMENTAL AND VOCAL LESSONS AT NEWQUAY TRETHERRAS

Terms and conditions

Students should politely excuse themselves from lessons in ADVANCE where possible and ensure that they complete all class and homework.

It is the student's responsibility to check the timetable in ADVANCE and see a music teacher if there is a problem.

Pupils receiving tuition are expected to take part in extra-curricular music as soon as they are able and to practice regularly on their instrument at home.

Music lessons missed due to student absence will be forfeited. Lessons missed through teacher absence will be made up by the teacher.

One term's written notice is required to cancel lessons and a charge will be made for the whole term.

Invoices will be sent out in advance at the start of every new term and must be paid before lessons can commence. Unfortunately, lessons missed due to non-payment cannot be refunded.

Refunds are normally available from missed lessons due to mock GCSE/SATS/modular tests, long term student absence, work experience and whole year school curriculum visits only. Students need to inform the instrumental teacher or Head of Music in these cases.

When bringing instruments into school your child may put the instrument in the music store cupboard. This is locked at the end of the day but NOT DURING the day. The school has no insurance policy to cover instruments therefore they should be included on parents' home-contents insurance. Students' instruments are brought in at parents own risk. Instruments must not be brought into school until this form has been signed and returned.

A limited number of instruments are available to hire from Cornwall Music Education Hub – contact them on cornwallmusiceducationhub.org. Parents are asked to include school instruments on their home contents policies.

Charging: £6.00 per lesson

Concessions: £4.00 per lesson if the student or his/her parent/carer is in receipt of disability allowance. The school must be provided with an updated copy of the award notice at the beginning of each term. This will be copied and returned.

Some concessions are available to students in receipt of free school meals or for those whose parents are current Service Personnel.

Payment method is by ParentPay only.
