SECONDARY SCHOOL-AGE NASAL FLU VACCINATION

Kernow Health is delivering the immunisation programme on behalf of NHS England. In 2022/23 **secondary school-age children in years 7, 8 and 9** will be eligible for the nasal flu vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray of mist up the nose. Please click on the link or enter <u>www.nhs.uk/child-flu</u> to access information explaining the vaccination programme which also includes details about the small number of children for whom the nasal vaccine is not appropriate. Flu can be a very unpleasant illness and sometimes causes serious complications. Vaccinating your child will also help protect more vulnerable friends and family by preventing the spread of flu.

Please submit your consent **by midday on Friday 9th December 2022** to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form please **telephone 01872 221105** and the team will be happy to help. Please note that as in previous years **you must opt in** to the programme. If a consent form is not submitted your child might not be vaccinated.

 Important: Your child can self-consent to treatment if they are considered competent to do so by one of our nurses; this is known as Gillick competency. If your child becomes wheezy or has their asthma medication increased after you submit this form, please contact Kernow Health on 01872 221105.

If you decide you do not want to vaccinate your child against flu, it will help us if you still complete and submit the form giving the reason. This will assist us in planning and developing the service. Please tell us if you need this information in a different format.
