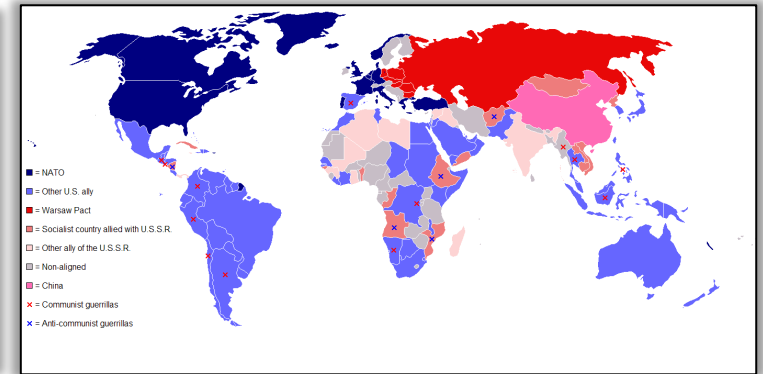
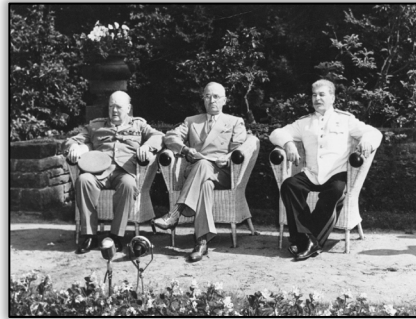

Outbound

NOTE: Flight times have been changed!

29th June 2023: Leave school at 3AM!

Luggage: Please pack light

Cabin bags

Everyone can bring one small cabin bag per person on board for free.

It can be a maximum size of 45 x 36 x 20 cm (including any handles or wheels) and needs to fit under the seat in front of you. That should be enough to bring all the essentials for your journey or for a short trip. Your bag can weigh up to 15kg, but we do ask that you're able to lift and carry it yourself.

▼ [Liquids](#)

You can only carry liquids, aerosols and gels in containers of 100ml or less when you pass through security. They should all fit into one transparent, re-sealable 20cm x 20cm bag.

In total, each customer can carry a maximum of 1,000ml through security. You can buy more liquids in the departure lounge should you need them.



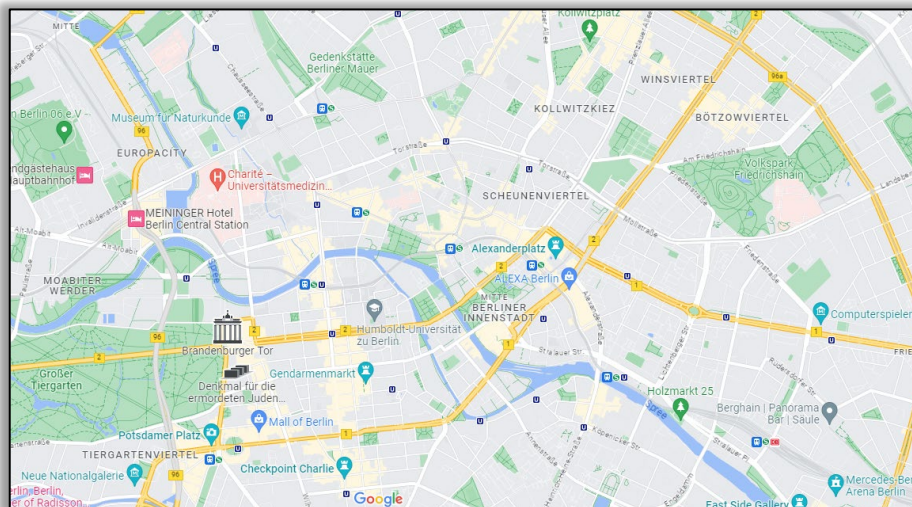
Accommodation

Meninger Hotel Berlin

- Single sex rooms
- Twins and Triples
- All rooms hopefully quite close together
- It is very central

Expectations

- Students will remain in the groups they have chosen. There won't be an opportunity to change once we are there.
- It is a hotel with other guests. I cannot accept running around the halls, shouting and screaming
- There needs to be a curfew. I don't care what time students are allowed to stay up at home.
- There will be a room check for damage when we check out. Students will be expected to pay for any damage in the room.
- Breakfast will be in the hotel every morning (early!) I don't care what time students are allowed to stay in until at home.
- Students must not leave the hotel under any circumstances other than an emergency.



Food

- Yes, they will be fed.
- I can't promise many salads.
- Breakfast will be at the hotel every morning. Continental
- Lunch will be 'on the hoof'
- Dinner will be at various points. Often we give students the opportunity and responsibility to find their own food.

NOTE: Because of the changes to flight times, I know have to consider two extra meals. Ordinarily there is money left to feed the kids on the way home. You may need to meet your child with some food, or students to have some money to buy food on return to UK.

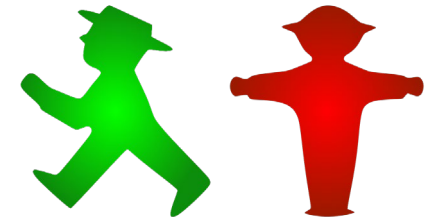

There is increased security around key buildings.

Alexanderplatz (pictured) is a busy transport and shopping hub.

There are trams, people, buses.....

Students under no circumstances are to go alone anywhere.

Expectation to be in threes or fours. I don't care if they are allowed to go off by themselves at home.

Students will be given free time and responsibility to shop, wander in Alexanderplatz. There is a clear boundary (but busy!!)
